The House and Senate are controlled by the same party. Nevertheless, with respect to possible substantial cuts to the Medicaid program:

- The House and the Senate can't agree on an amount to cut from the federal budget
- The House and the Senate set different amounts to cut from the federal budget

- The House and the Senate have set up a looming showdown over Medicaid
